The Georgetown University Transportation Shuttle (GUTS)

is a FREE shuttle for faculty, staff, students and all associates and patients of MedStar Georgetown University Hospital (MGUH). The Hospital supplements this FREE shuttle service with buses from International Limo. These buses connect you with the Rosslyn and Dupont Circle Metro stations. The GUTS buses also serve the GU Law Center, Capitol Hill, Wisconsin Avenue, and Arlington, Virginia. The buses operate between 5 a.m. and midnight and are FREE of charge for all MGUH personnel. On holidays, the buses operate only on a rush hour schedule. All shuttle buses drop off in the shuttle bus loop by the Southwest Quad and McDonough Gym. Simply show your MGUH identification badge and ride for FREE. From the bus loop, the GU Mini Shuttle is available to take you directly to the PHC building entrance at the Hospital.

G Commuter Rail

Both MARC and VRE rail lines serve Union Station in D.C., making these commuter rail options a great choice for MGUH associates. From Union Station, associates have many options to access MGUH. Both Metrobus and the DC Circulator serve Union Station, as well as the Red Line, which can take you to Dupont Circle to catch the FREE MGUH shuttle.

Zipcar

Zipcar is the world's largest carsharing program, allowing members to pay a monthly fee for use of an automobile when they want them all over the United States. MGUH associates have access to eight Zipcars nearby: five cars parked on Tondorf Road in front of Village C and three cars parked at the north end of GU by the corner of Darnall Hall (by the Student Health Center and Epicurean). Additionally, there are three Zipcars available near MGUH at 33rd Street and Wisconsin Avenue, Wisconsin Avenue and O Street, and behind 3237 N Street. MGUH is easily accessed from either the Rosslyn (Orange, Blue and Silver Lines) or Dupont Circle (Red Line) Stations. MGUH and GUTS shuttle buses provide FREE service to the Rosslyn and Dupont Circle Metro stations. Additionally, Metrobus and the DC Circulator serve both Metro stations.

SmartBenefits

MGUH associates who use Metrorail, Metrobus and other eligible forms of public transportation can receive pre-tax benefits by enrolling in the WMATA SmartBenefits program. SmartBenefits allows MGUH associates to deduct funds from their paychecks before taxes and add them to their SmarTrip card. Funds are automatically added each month and any unused benefits are rolled over to the next month. Visit the Parking Office in Garage 1 for more information.

Guaranteed Ride Home

Any MGUH associate who commutes by not driving to work is eligible for a FREE and guaranteed ride home by enrolling in the Guaranteed Ride Home program sponsored by Commuter Connections and the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments. This program allows for up to four FREE taxi rides or rental car reimbursements a year for anyone enrolled in the program, alleviating the worry of getting stranded at work due to missing the last bus or needing to get somewhere in a hurry. In order to use this service, you must register through <u>Commuter</u>. <u>Connections</u>, commute by not driving alone at least two days a week, and can only use the service on a day where you did not drive alone. MGUH is served directly by the D6 Metrobus and indirectly at nearby stops by the G2, D2, 38B, 30N, 30S, 31 and 33 Metrobuses. Additionally, the DC Circulator Dupont-Georgetown-Rosslyn route and Georgetown-Union Station route serve MGUH indirectly with stops in the nearby neighborhood. Both Metrobuses and DC Circulator buses accept SmarTrip cards.

MGUH has various Capital Bikeshare Stations nearby. Capital Bikeshare is a point-to-point bicycling system that allows you to take a bike from one bikeshare station and return it to another, making it a great option for commuting. With stations at 37th and O Streets, Wisconsin Avenue and O Street, and Wisconsin Avenue and 34th Street, Capital Bikeshare is convenient and easy to use.

MGUH is also surrounded by bicycle-friendly streets and trails, which make biking to work very easy. MGUH has bike racks available at various locations, including outside Garage 1 and on the CCC outdoor podium level.



In addition to providing the Guaranteed Ride Home service, <u>Commuter Connections</u> makes it easy for you to carpool or vanpool to work by connecting you with others in your community who may be traveling in the same direction. Not only is ridesharing an affordable way to travel by sharing costs of the commute, but it also allows you to use the HOV and ExpressLanes in the region and without penalty to get where you going quicker and make your commute more reliable.

Similar to carpooling, vanpooling offers commuters the option of riding with six or more people to and from work each day, which reduces the cost of commuting even further and still allows access to the region's HOV and ExpressLanes. Both <u>Vride</u> and <u>Enterprise Rideshare</u> offer vanpools throughout the region.
